

Brian J. Grim is president of the Religious Freedom & Business Foundation and a leading expert on the socioeconomic impact of restrictions on religious freedom and international religious demography. He holds a visiting professorship at St. Mary's, Twickenham, where he is developing the RFBF's Empowerment+ initiative to increase religious freedom by countering radicalisation. Grim served as 2015–2016 chair of the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on the Role of Faith and works closely with the Business for Peace platform of the United Nations Global Compact. From 2006 to 2014 Grim directed the largest social science effort to collect and analyze global data on religion at the Pew Research Center. He also worked for two decades as an educator in the former Soviet Union, China, Central Asia, the Middle East, and Europe. He is author of numerous articles and books, including *The Price of Freedom Denied* (2010), and writes the *Weekly Number* blog. He was an associate scholar with the Berkley Center's Religious Freedom Project from 2014 to 2016. Grim holds a doctorate from the Pennsylvania State University. This year, the G20 Interfaith Summit Association is proud to offer an **add-on certificate course**. On Saturday, 17 June 2017, Brian J. Grim of the Religious Freedom and Business Foundation will offer a one-day Empowerment Plus Facilitator training and certificate programme. Some of the factors that lead to radicalization are poor leadership, lack of meaningful jobs, and lack of solid spiritual grounding. Empowerment Plus Facilitator training is designed to equip participants with the tools to build social cohesion and counter extremism by engaging youth in interfaith action, helping them become leaders, find meaningful jobs, and start new businesses, with values centered on spiritual principles shared by all, such as integrity, faith, and service.



The Empowerment Plus Facilitator programme will train and certify participants to facilitate two of the three Empowerment Plus courses, Find a Better Job and Launching Leaders, and will introduce attendees to the Master of Business on the Streets (MBS), a separate training to be offered at a later date. Participants will receive a certificate of completion and a license to use the Empowerment Plus resources, most of which are totally free.
